Who Is Chipukizi For?

Is My Child Safe?

We understand the sensitivity of the ages we are dealing with and hence have made several arrangements to address possible concerns from parents as follow:

- The children will first be assembled in an IAT Loita room under their trainers supervision as they await their bus shuttled
- They shall always travel with a trainer and qualified first-aider on board
- Class sessions will have more than one trainer sitting in for personalized attention
- Outdoor activities will be supervised by both the trainer and first-aider
- The children will be in secure premises (former Augustana College at Kasarani).
